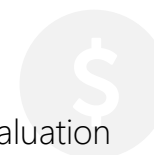

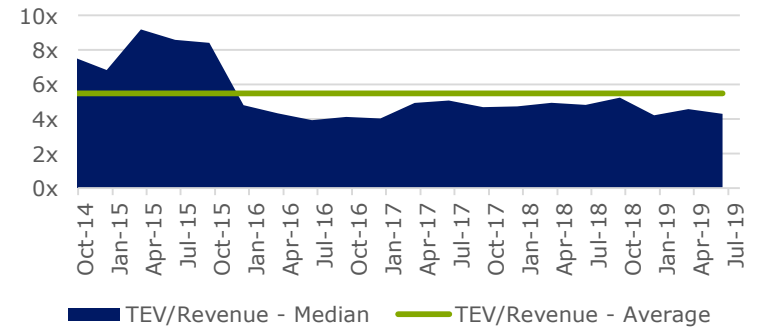

Public Revenue Multiples over Time



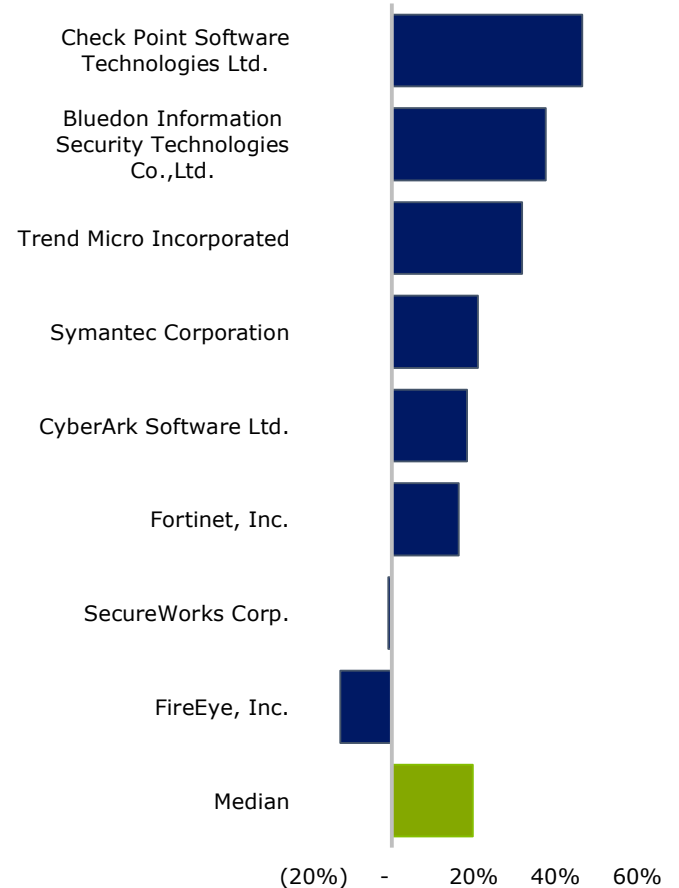

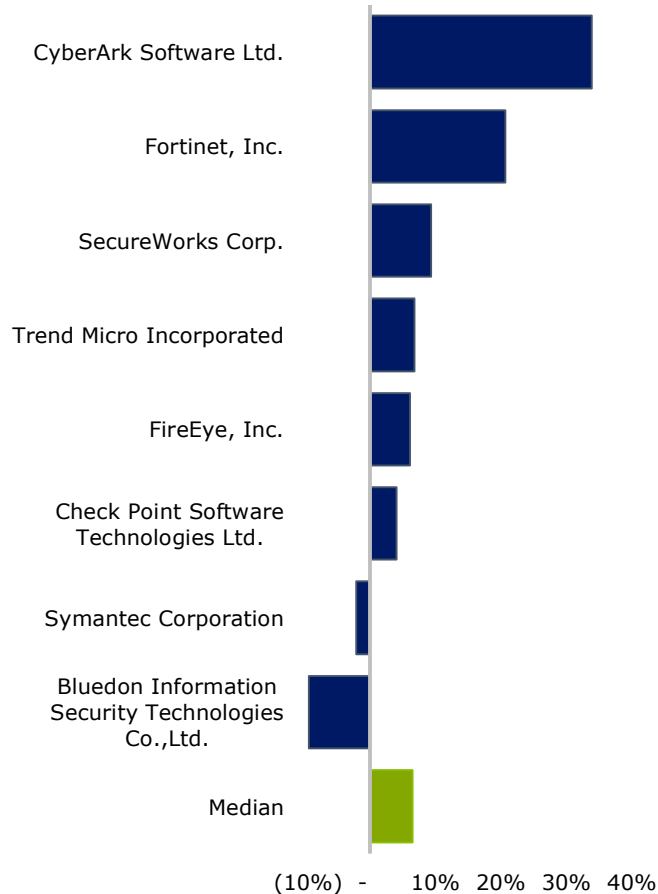

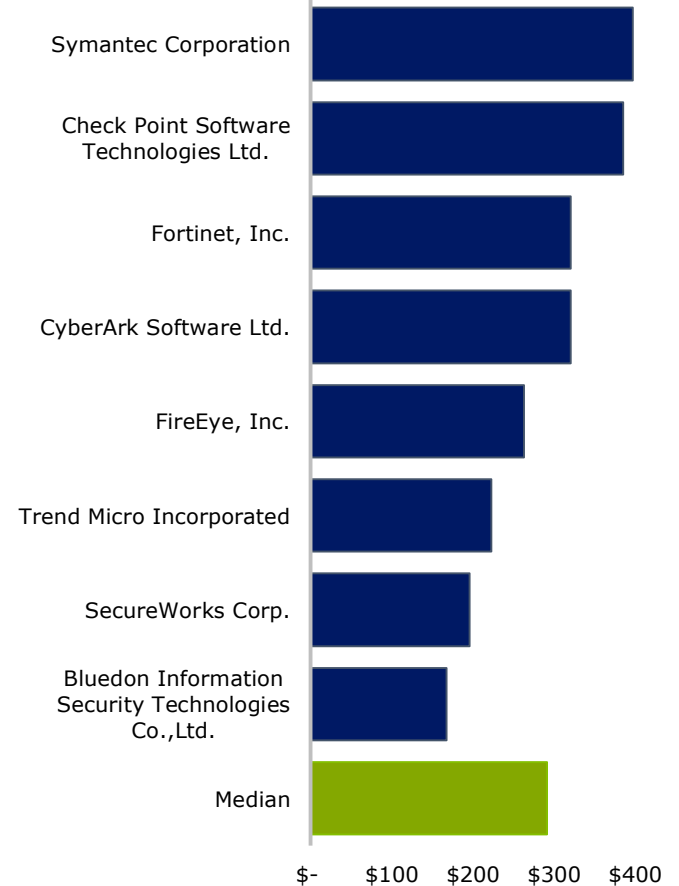

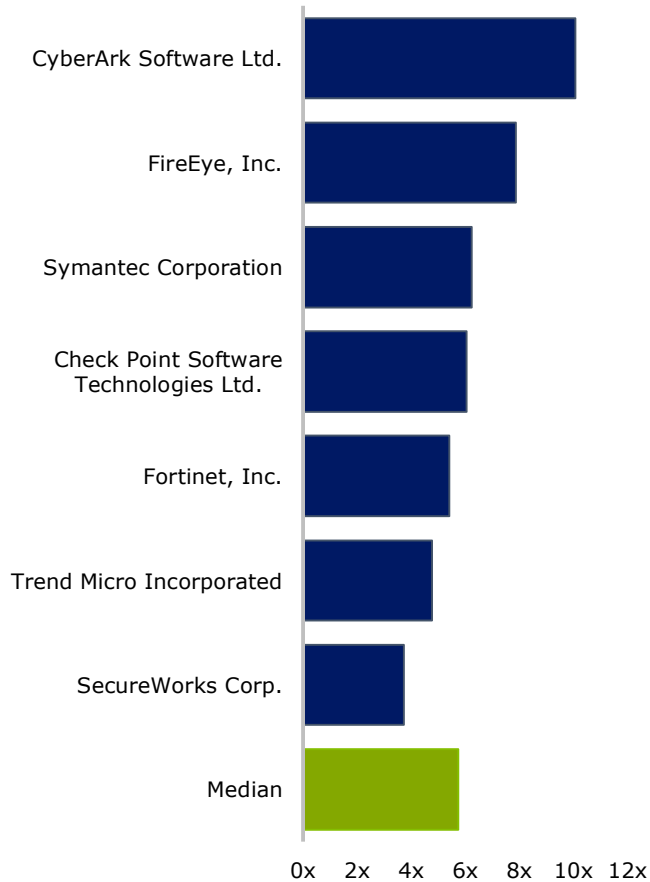

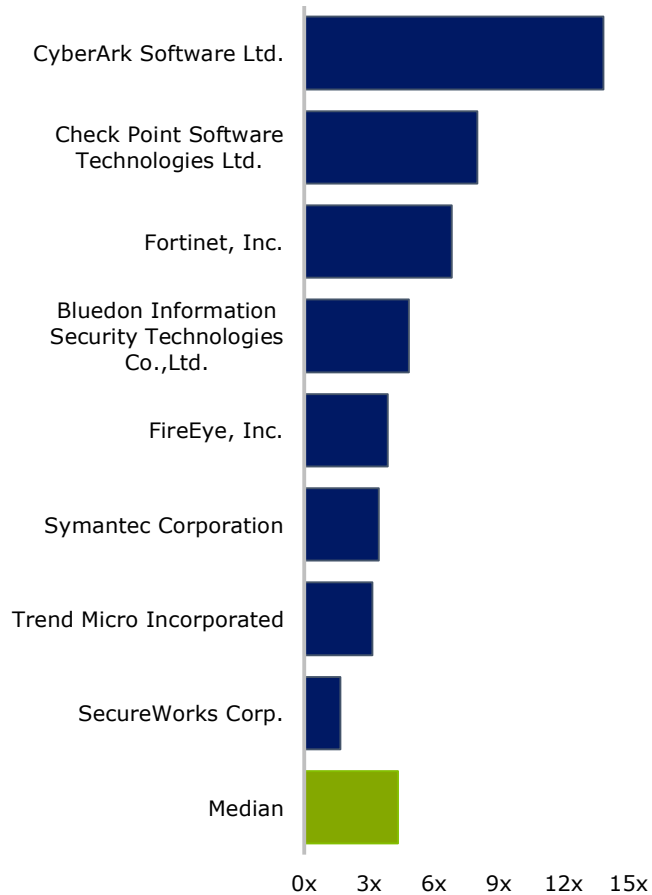

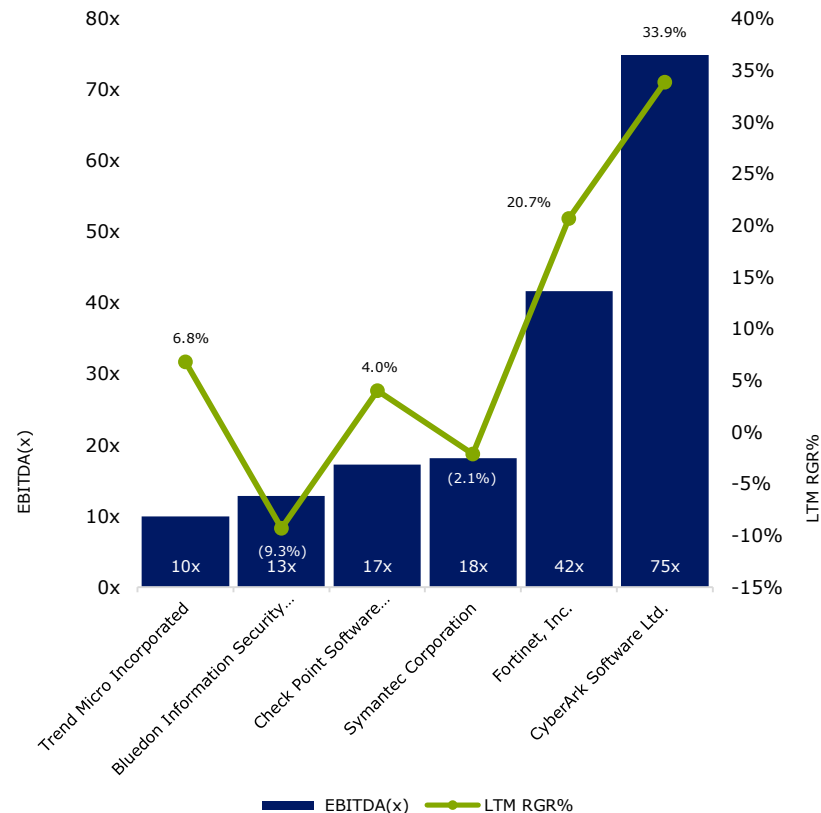

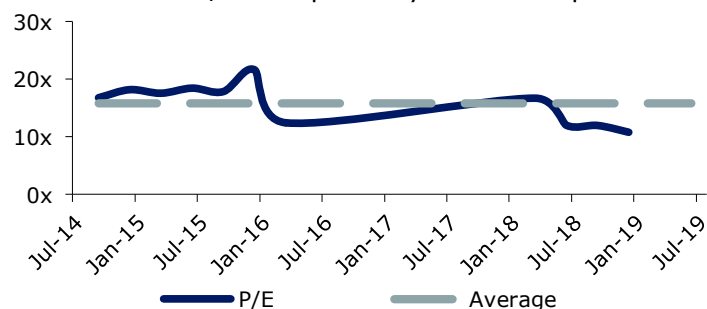
Revenue Multiples - Symantec Corporation
