











Public Revenue Multiples over Time





LTM Gross Profit Margin %




LTM EBITDA %




LTM Revenue Growth %





The company raised GBP 15.45 million of Series E2 venture funding through a combination of debt and equity on July 20, 2020, putting the company's pre-money valuation at GBP 50.16 million. GBP 5.45 million of venture funding was raised from Robert Bosch Venture Capital, Target Global, Huawei Technologies Company, Xilinx Infineon Technologies, Kew Capital China, Lanza techVentures and 6 other investors. A GBP 9.99 of loan was provided by Harbert Management. The company will use the funding for it's continued growth and an expanded global presence, including new staff, in the office and for development of its AloT solution portfolio.









ABB Group
